HIGH SCHOOL and FURTHER EDUCATION COLLEGE INCLUDING :

 380 HND students (they take a 2 year-post-A level diploma or 2 years'degree) in agriculture, landscape management, horticulture, plant & animal production

1700 15-18 year-old pupils studying:

- sciences (maths, physics & biology)
- economics
- agriculture and environment, plant & animal production
- 600 APPRENTICES in floristry, farming, gardening & landscaping A TRAINING CENTER FOR PROFESSIONNALS

- 1 higher education department with 380 HND students in plant production, animal breeding, horticulture, landcaping and farming and management (students above 18 – Further education college)
 - 3 high schools (students under 18):
 - General high school (2 options : math/sciences or economics) (1100 students)
 - Technological high school (landscaping, animal and plant production and environment) (300 pupils)
 - Vocational High school (landscaping, farming, horticulture, commerce) (300 pupils)

- Since May 2010, Institut de
 Genech has been a full
 member of the UNESCO
 Associated Schools network
 that aims at mobilizing young
 people around the ideals of
 UNESCO : Peace, International
 understanding, human rights,
 universal access to knowledge
 and sustainable development.
- Thanks to this network, some pupils attend classes in Japan or India for 3 or 6 months.

- Since 2010, we have been creating a network of European partners and professionals via Erasmus projects.
- 100 HND students per year do a placement abroad (Ireland, the Netherlands, Canada, Poland, Great Britain, Denmark, Malta...)
- 400 HND students and A levels pupils do each year study trips to Spain, Greece, Great Britain, Ireland, India, Japan, Italy...
